

Church Regulations

The following requirements represent the conditions set forward by the Incumbent for the use of the Parish Church.

1. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall be placed on or in the Font.
2. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall be placed on the Holy Table.
3. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall be permitted on the Pulpit or Lectern.
4. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall obstruct the aisles or entrance/exit from the Church.
5. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall be placed upon pews, seats or church furnishings without prior consultation with the Rector or person nominated by the Rector.
6. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall be attached to the exterior of the Church.
7. No floral arrangements, displays or representations of any kind shall be permitted on Church Grounds in the vicinity of the memorial plots adjacent to the Church.
8. No confetti/rice/flower petals etc shall be used within the Church or Church grounds .
9. If flowers are to be donated to the Church such must be confirmed with the Rector at least one week prior to the wedding/event.
10. The Select Vestry has set the fees. Available on request

The Officiant (Minister) commands no fee. This is a ministry of the Church to the marrying couple so please offer no gratuity. (Nb. Said custom applies only if the Rector of the Parish or his/her locum is acting as Officiant).

Please remember that a Church is a sacred space, not merely a wedding venue, and must be treated accordingly.
